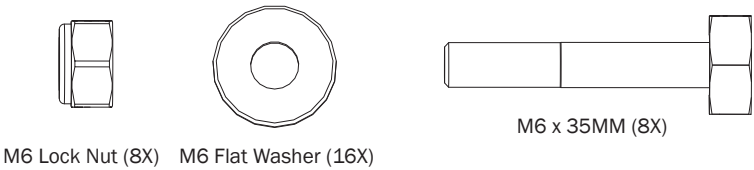
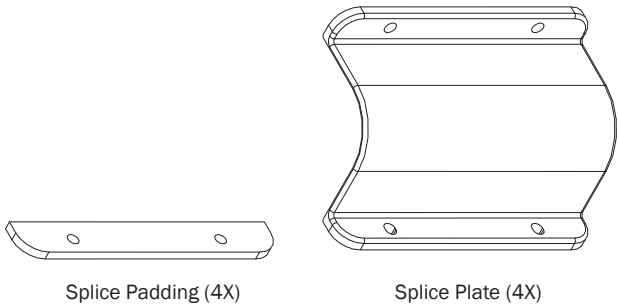


1—Front Conduit Tube Splice..... (Qty 1)

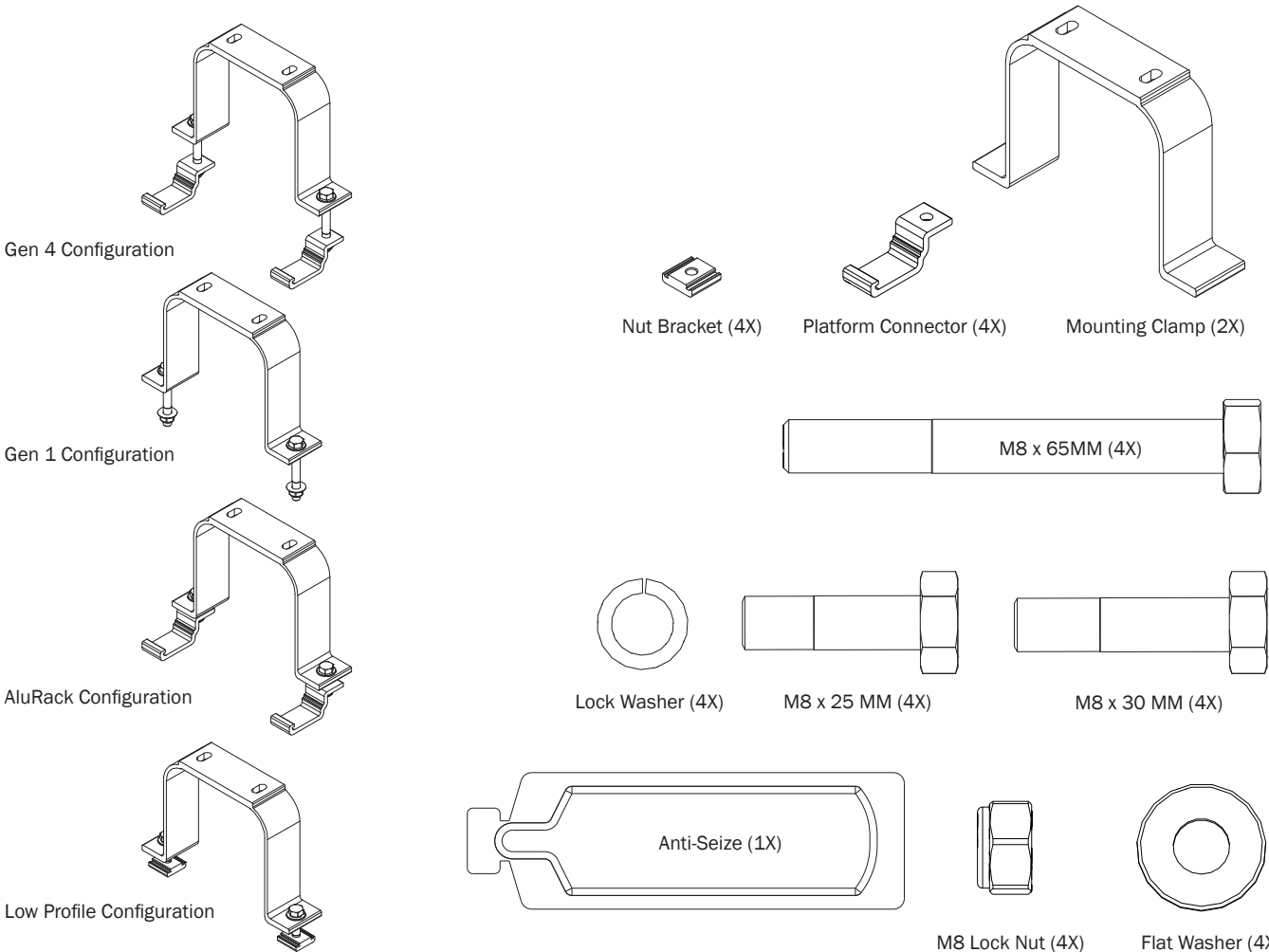


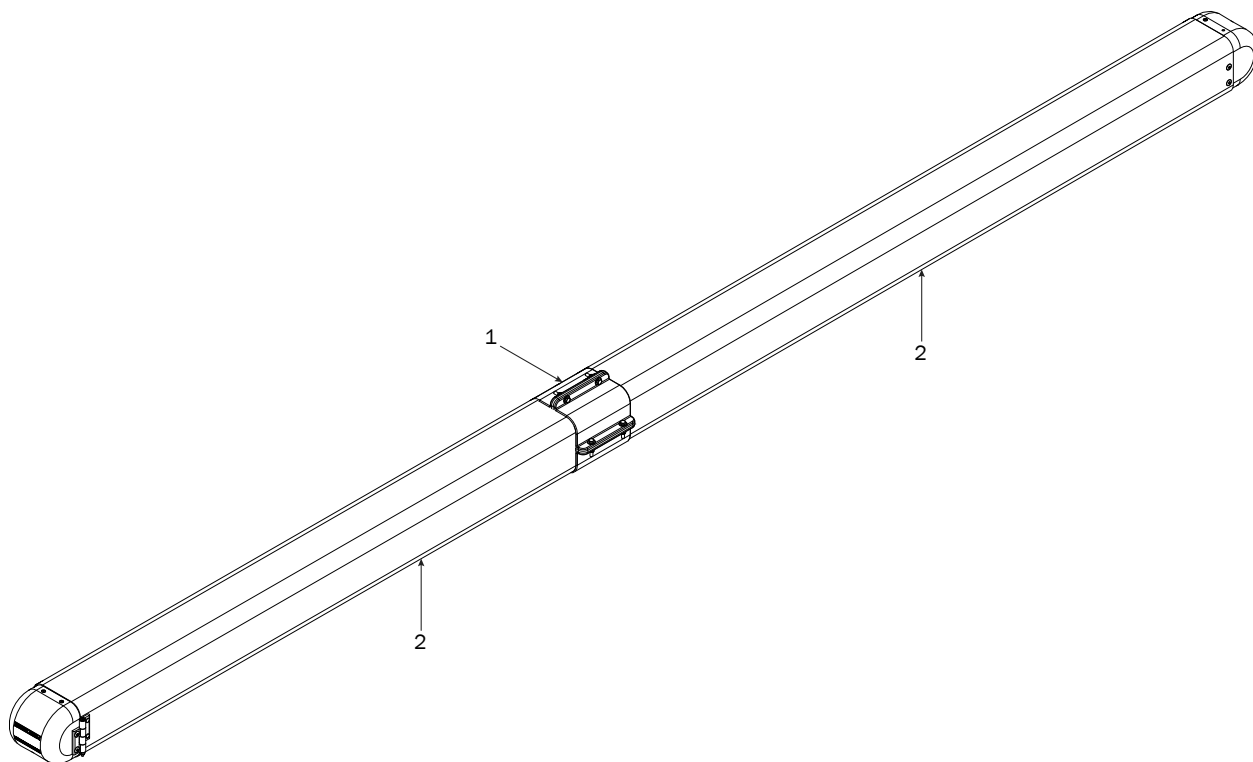
2—Rear Conduit Tube Splice (Qty 1)



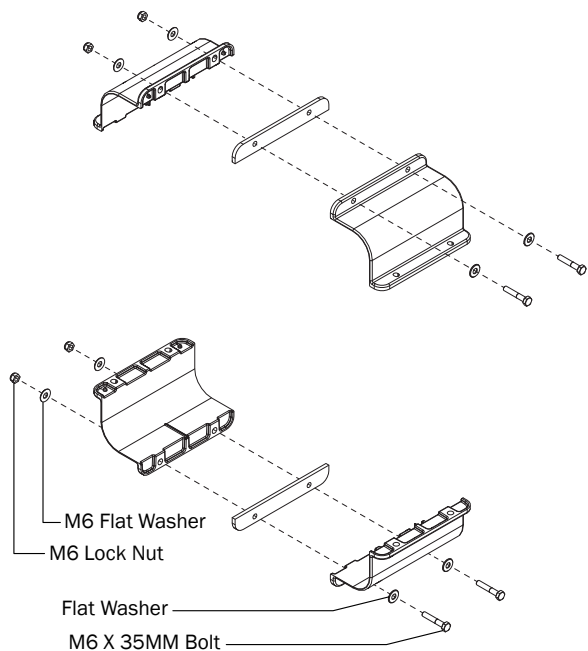

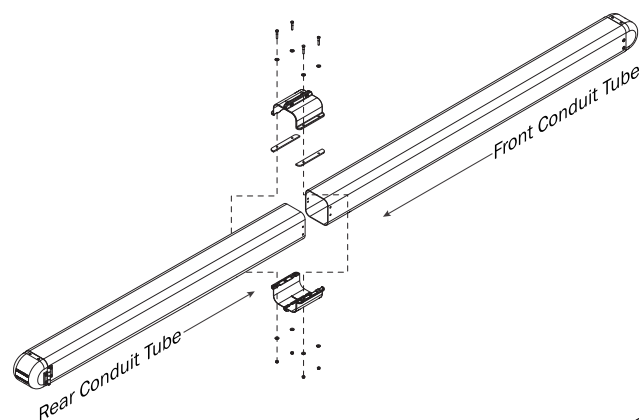


SPLICED CONDUIT TUBE ASSEMBLY SEQUENCE*CONDUIT TUBE SPLICE*

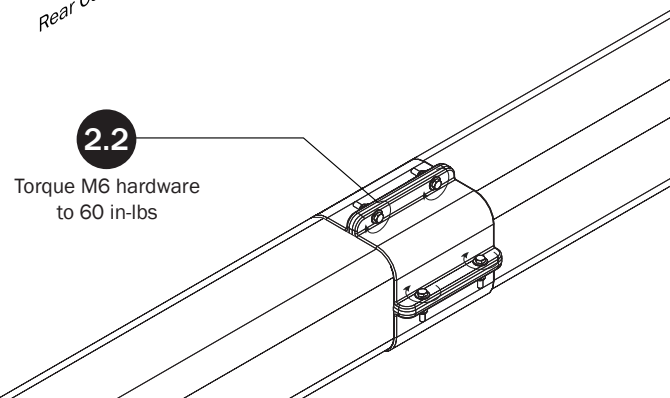
- 1** Assemble the left and right halves of the Splice Assembly. Do not tighten the M6 Bolts until step 2.2

*CONDUIT TUBE*

- 2.1** Assemble the Front and Rear Conduit Splices, and the top and bottom halves of the Splice Assembly. Ensure the Conduit Tubes contact each other within the Tube Splice Assembly. Do not tighten the M6 hardware until step 2.2

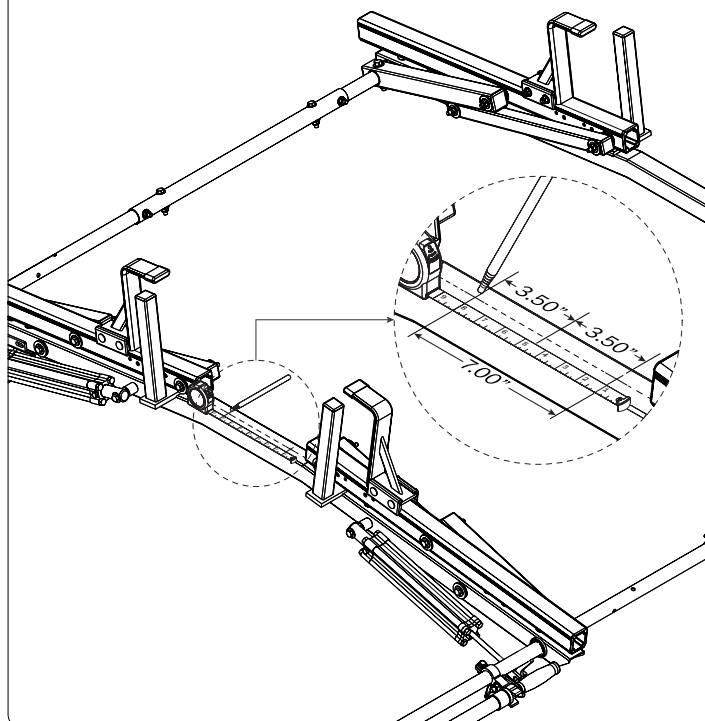

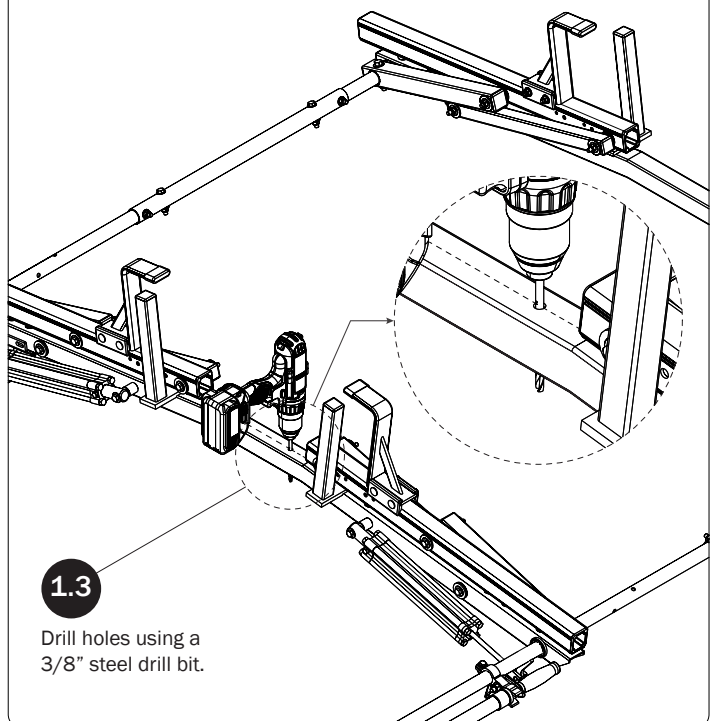
NOTE: Not all Gen 1 Crossbars are factory drilled to receive accessories. If not drilled, preperform Steps 1.1 to 2.3. If factory drilled, proceed to Step 3.1. Additionally, not all Gen 1 racks will have enough space between the Rotation Uppers to fit a Conduit Carrier. A minimum of 7.00" is required between the Uppers, and on the Crossbar's top, so measure prior to drilling to ensure there will be no Rotation interference.

CROSSBAR PREPARATION-REAR

- 1.1** Find the center of the top of Rear Crossbar between the inner bends. Using a grease pencil, mark the center, then measure out 3.50" to the left and right of that center mark and mark again using the grease pencil. The marked distances will measure 7.00" across as shown below.



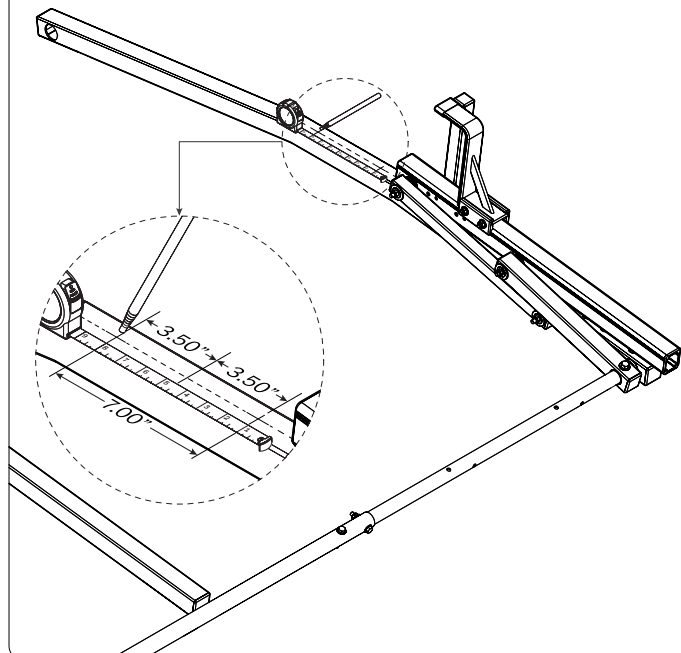
- 1.2** Prior to drilling, mark a center line along the length of the Crossbar to ensure the holes are correctly centered.



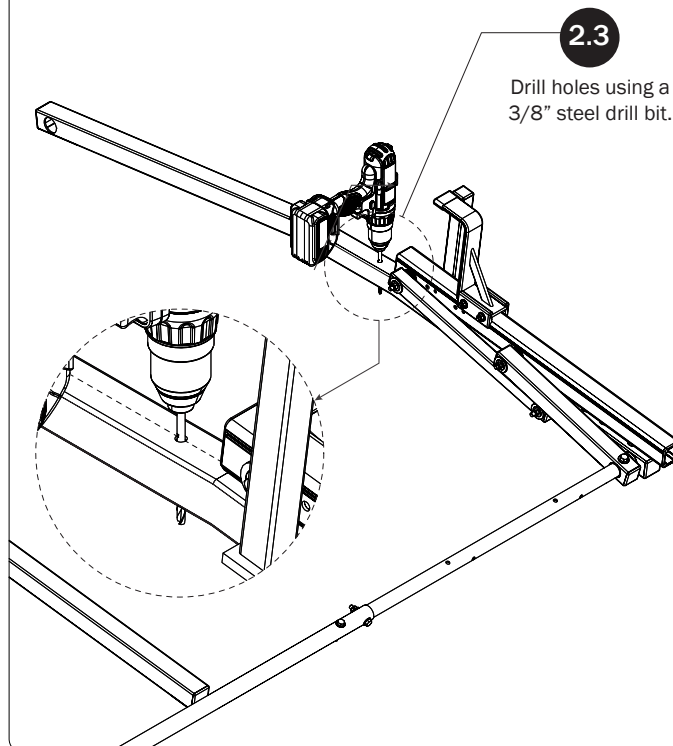
- 1.3** Drill holes using a 3/8" steel drill bit.

CROSSBAR PREPARATION-FRONT

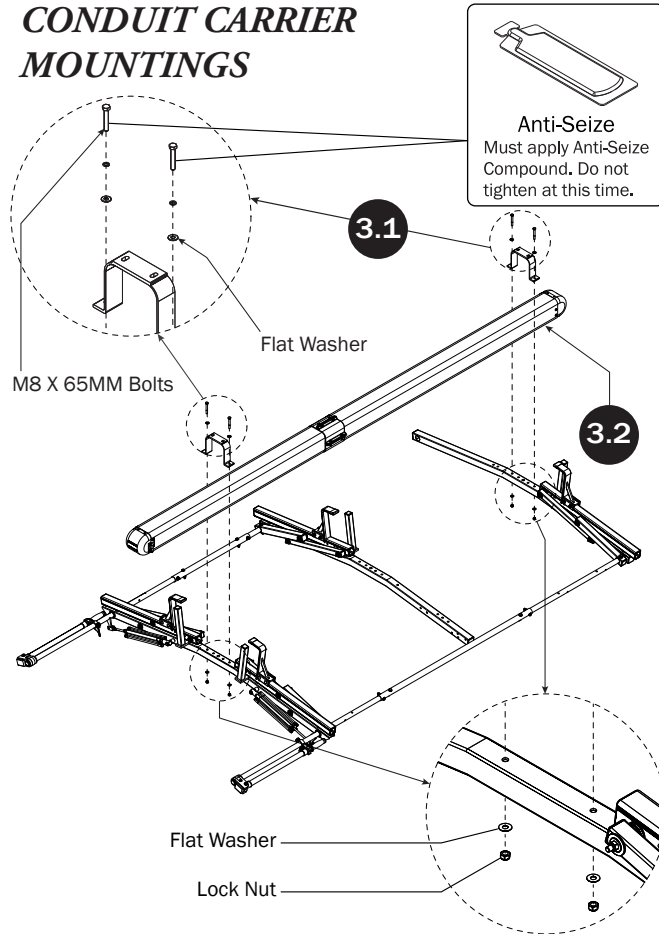
- 2.1** Find the center of the top of Front Crossbar between the inner bends. Using a grease pencil, mark the center, then measure out 3.50" to the left and right of that center mark and mark again using the grease pencil. The marked distances will measure 7.00" across as shown below.



- 2.2** Prior to drilling, mark a center line along the length of the Crossbar to ensure the holes are correctly centered.

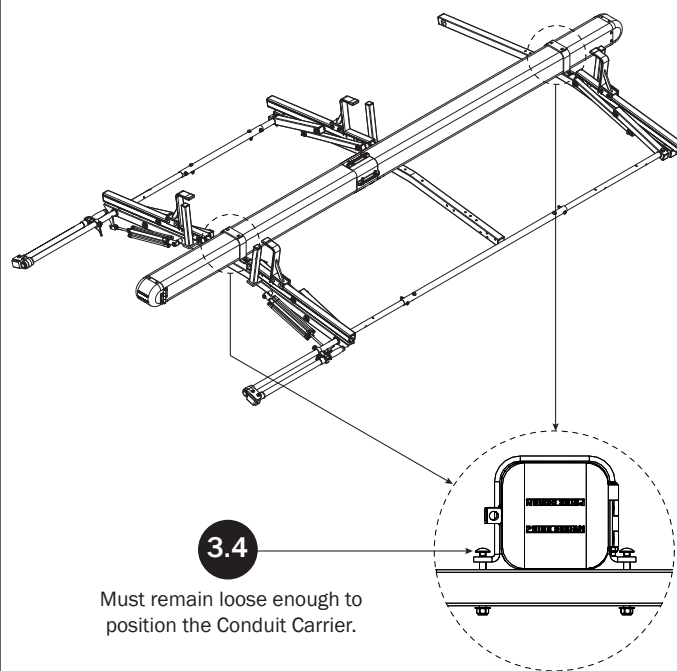

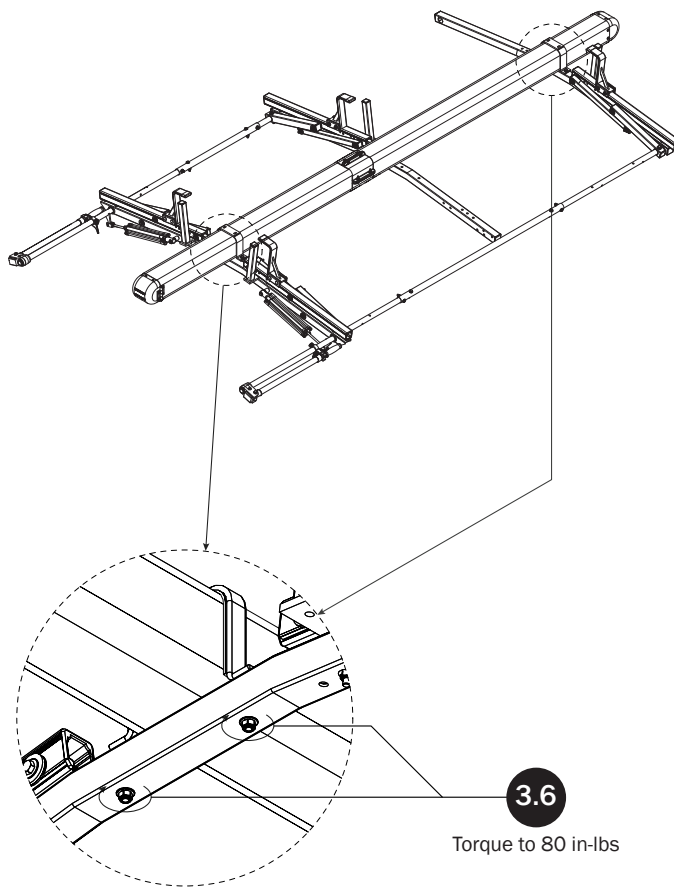
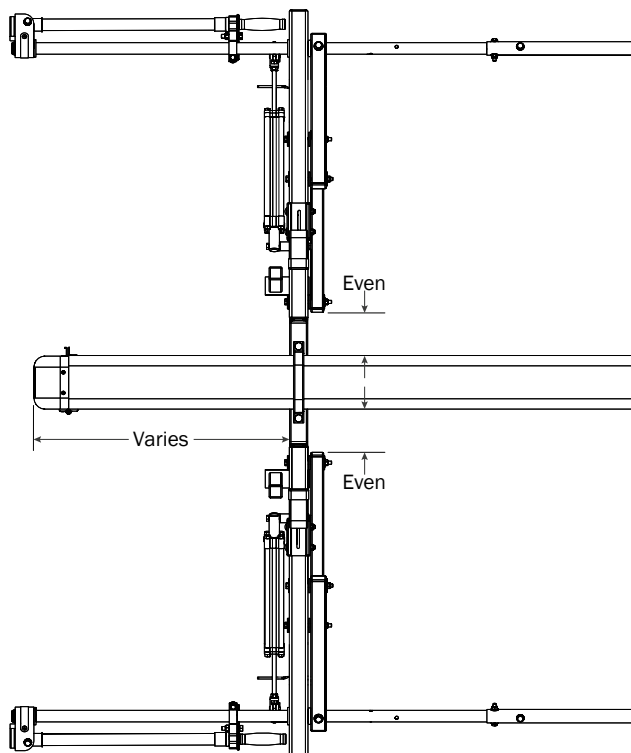
- 3.3** Place Conduit Carrier onto Crossbars, then assemble Conduit Carrier Mountings on top securing the Conduit Carrier to the Crossbars using the provided hardware. Do not tighten the Mountings until Step 3.6.

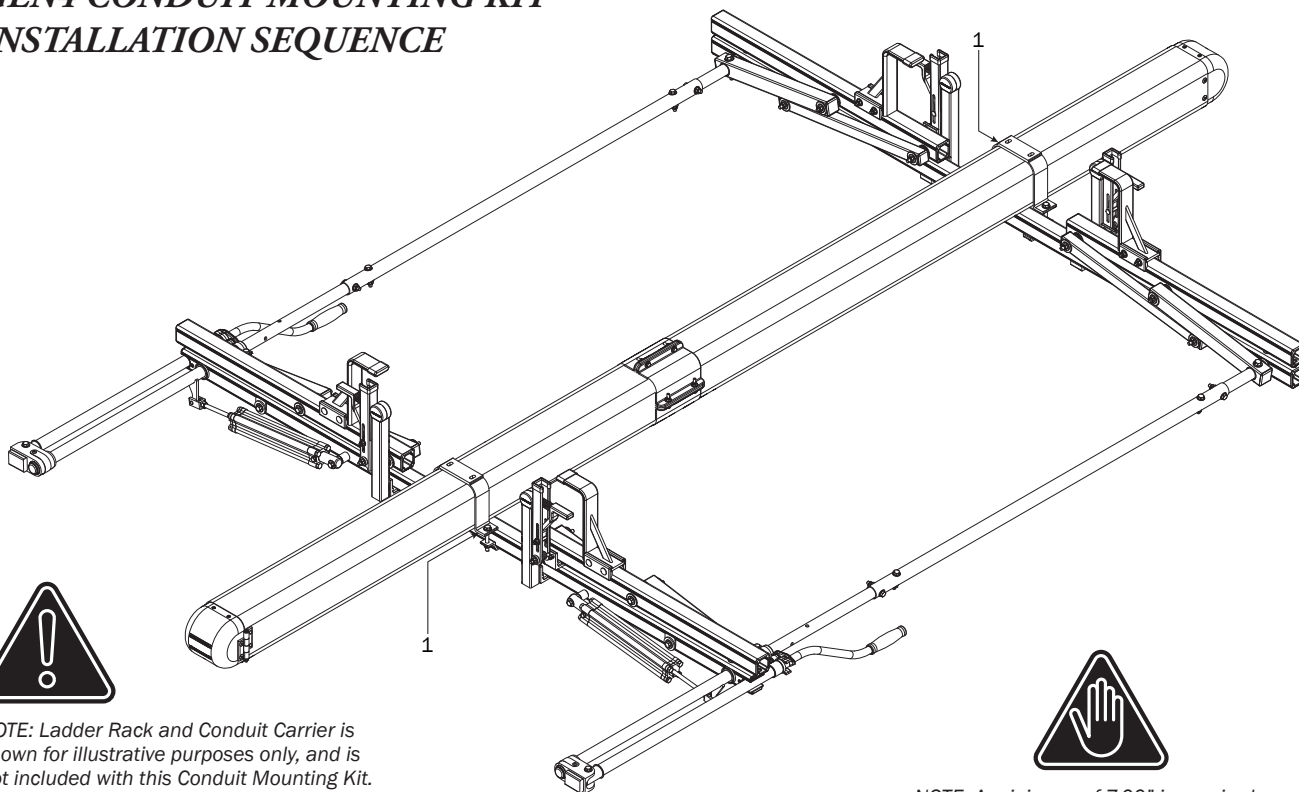

GEN4 CONDUIT MOUNTING KIT INSTALLATION SEQUENCE

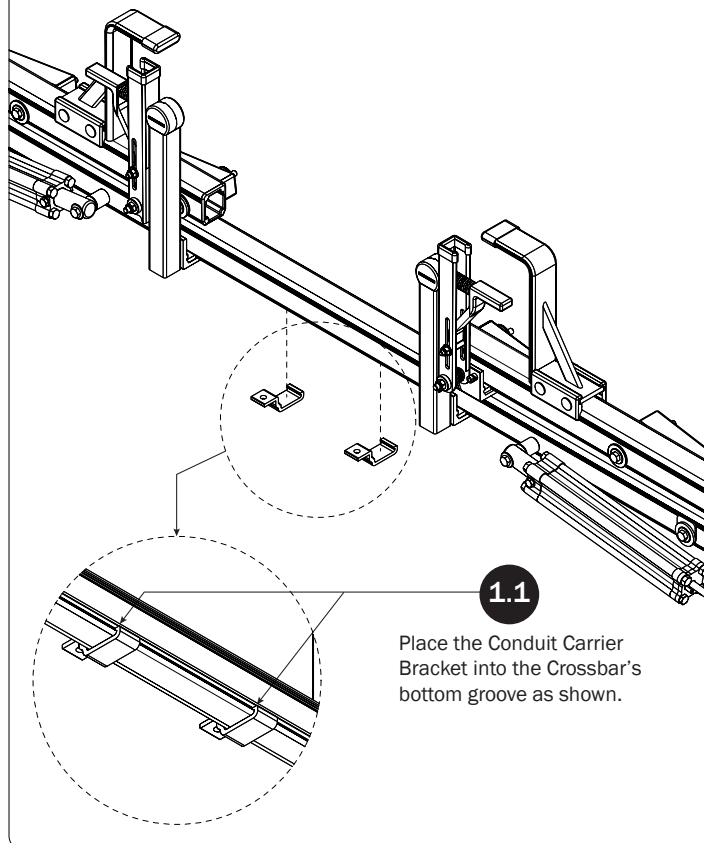

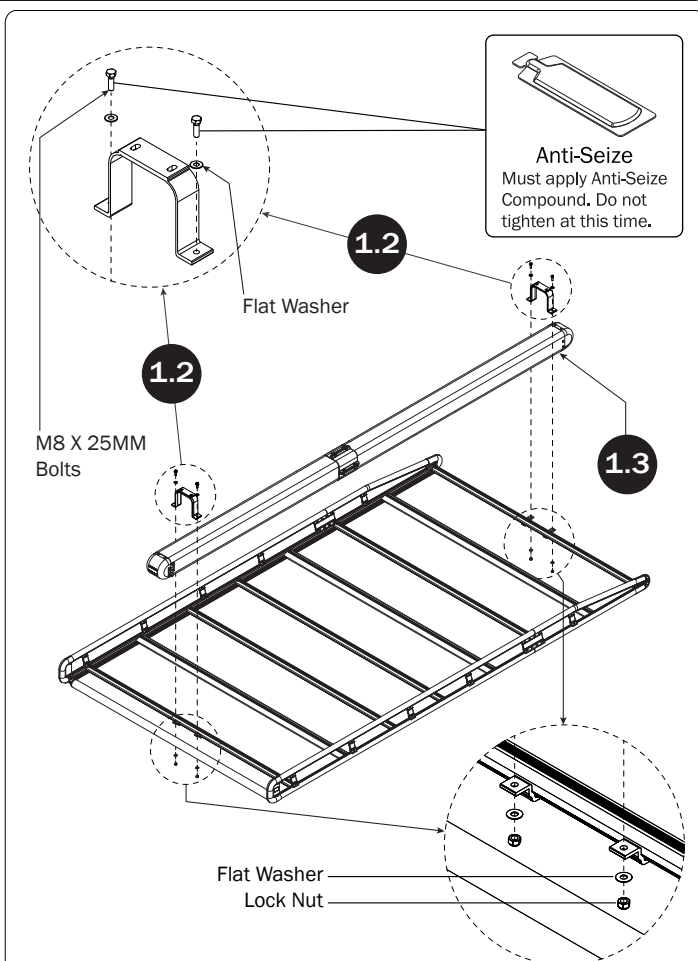
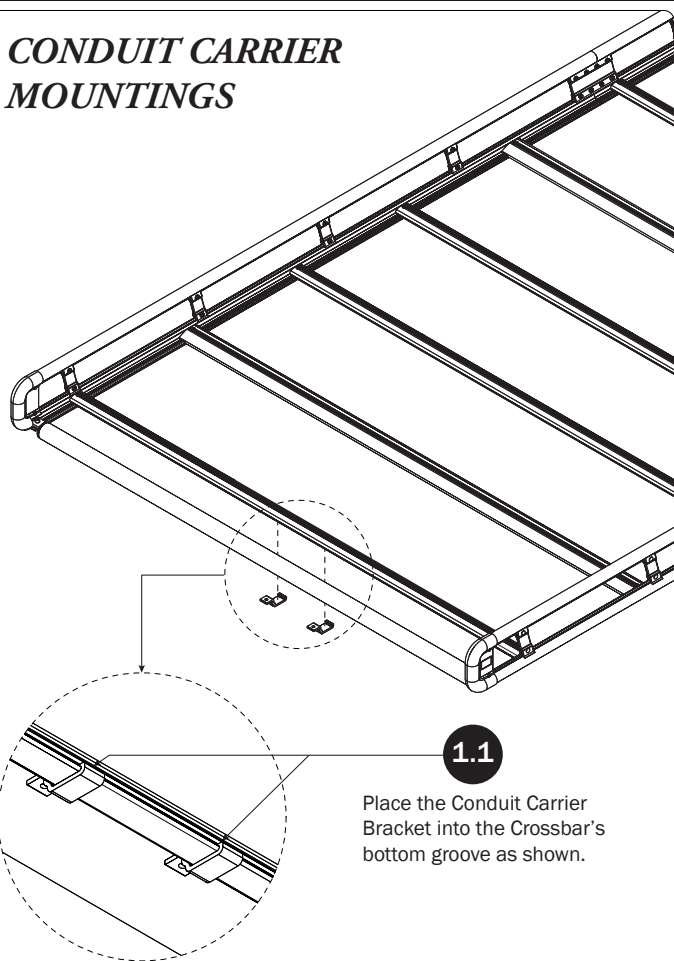
ALURACK CONDUIT MOUNTING KIT INSTALLATION SEQUENCE

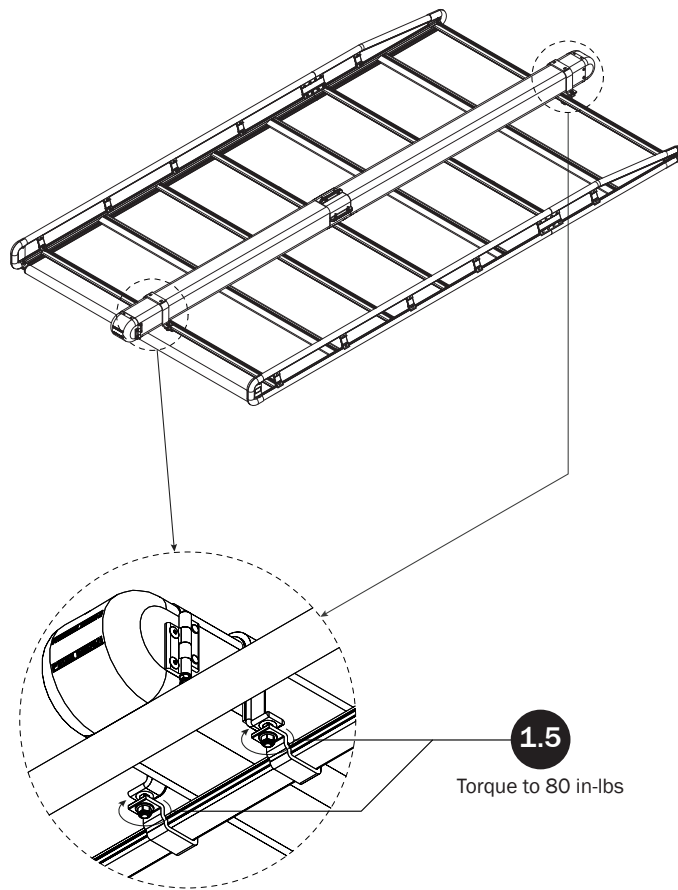
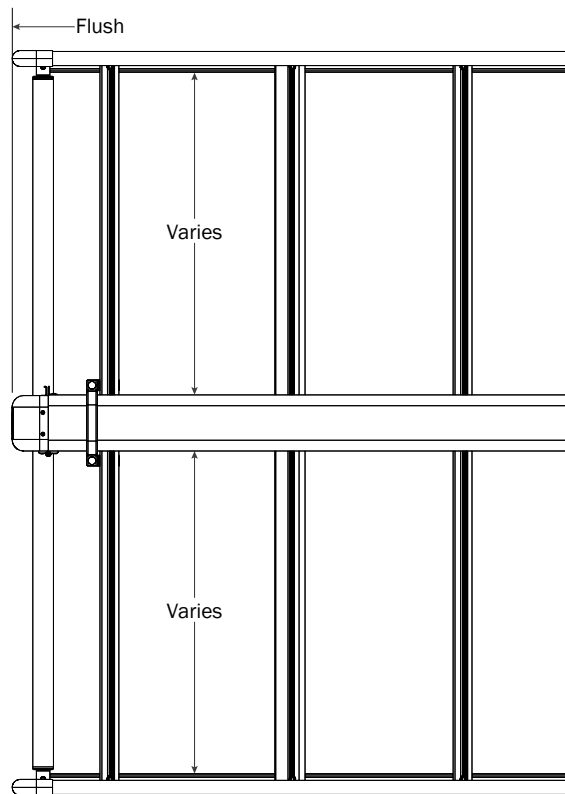

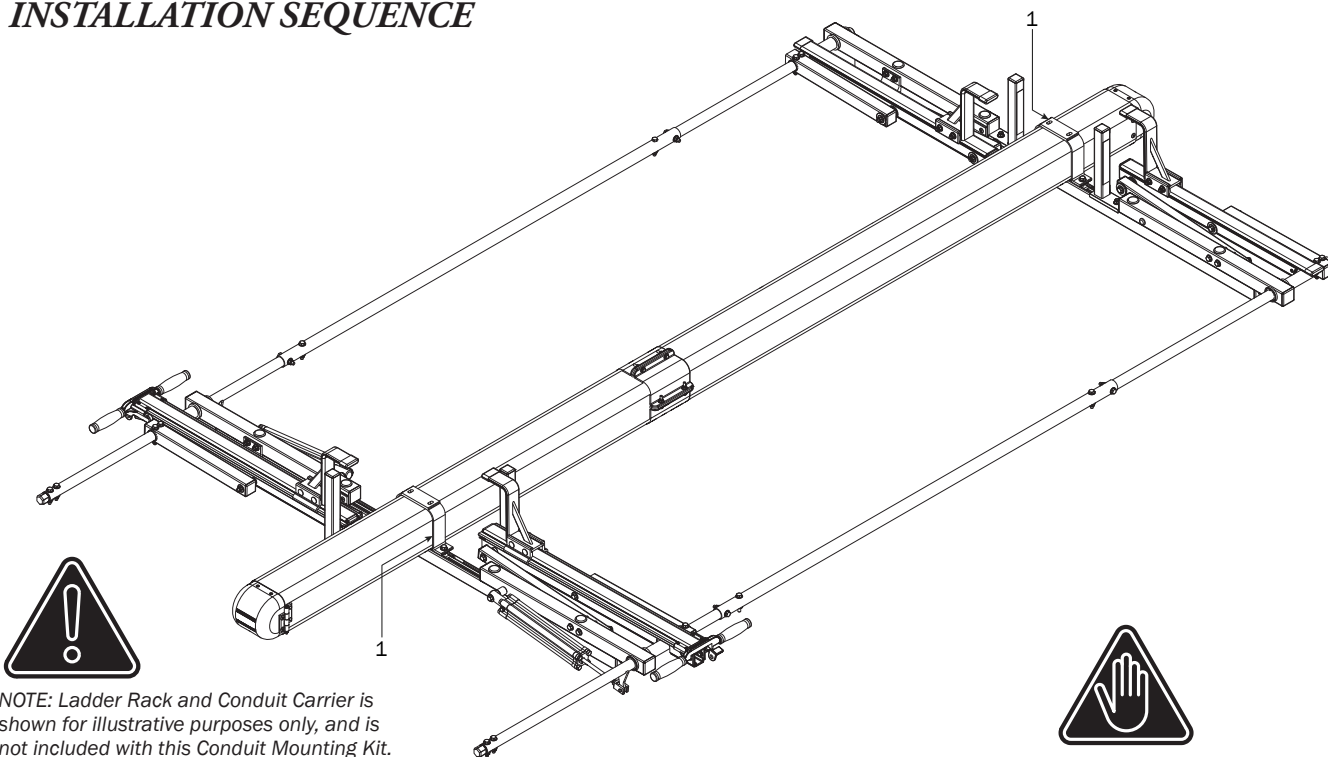

Position the Conduit Carrier anywhere between the side rails ensuring the Conduit Mountings to not interfere with the AluRack Mounting Brackets attaching the rack to the vehicle roof. The Conduit Carrier must not exceed the rear most end of the AluRack side rail.



LOW PROFILE MOUNTING KIT INSTALLATION SEQUENCE



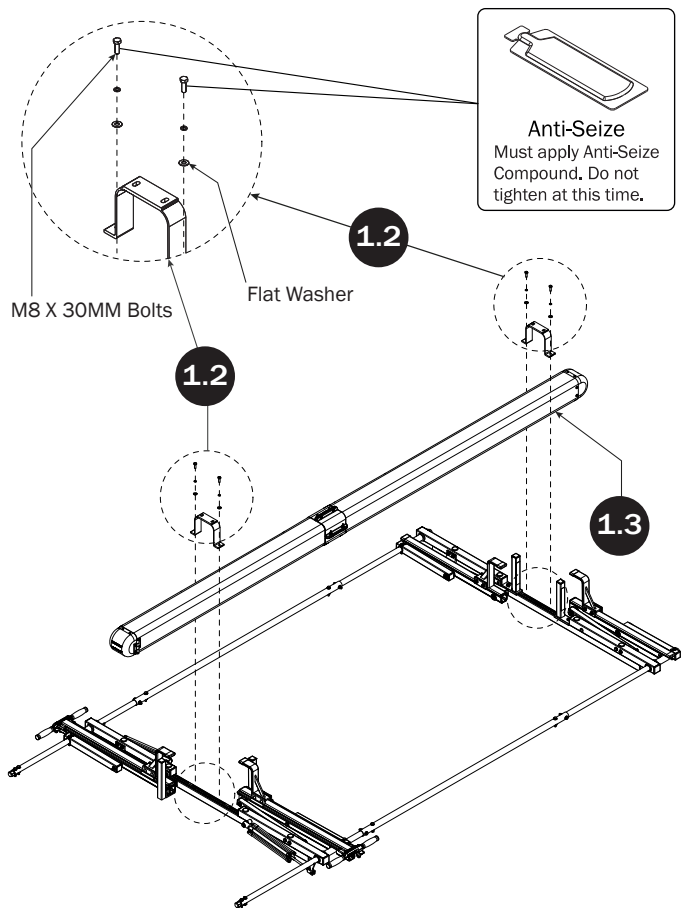
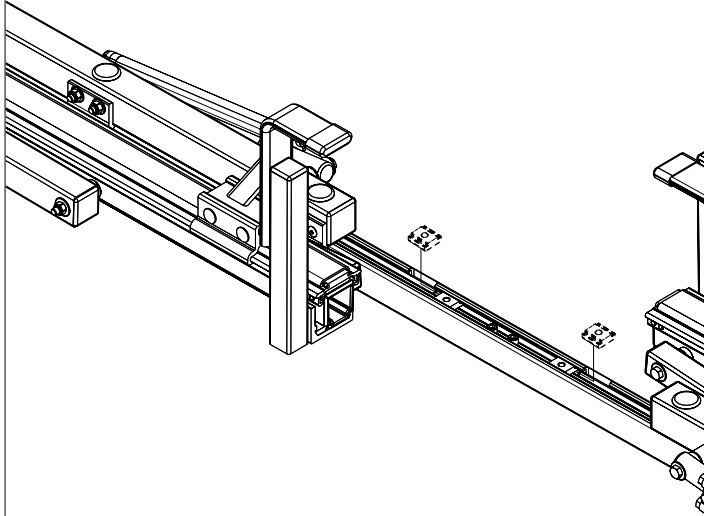
